For use in the following applications:

Paints, stains, latex emulsions, aqueous metalworking, cuttings, cooling and lubricating fluids and concentrated paper and paper coatings, plastics and plastics coatings, cordage, inks, wood preservatives, sapstain, building materials, adhesives, caulks, patching compounds, sealants, grouts, latex used in flooring adhesives or carpet backing, and for use in unregistered treated article intermediates that will be further manufactured.
