The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

Proposed Amendment

- Label Amendment: Update Storage and Disposal statements per PRN 2007-4

Conditions

Revise Label to Read:

- 1.) You must update the 8th statement under the your Precautionary Statements to read:

“Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling and before eating, drinking, chewing gum, using tobacco, or using the toilet.”

- 2.) Revise the phrase, “For use in the following applications” under the directions for use to read “for formulation in to antimicrobial products for use in/on

- 3 PRN 2005-1, Guidance for Mandatory and Advisory Labeling Statements, states that:

Mandatory statements, which commonly use imperative verbs such as “must” or “shall”, either require action or prohibit the user from taking certain action. **Advisory statements** generally provide information, either in support of the mandatory statements or about the product in general. **To ensure that the intent of each labeling statement is clear, mandatory statements need to be clearly distinguishable from advisory statements.**

Therefore, you must change the term “Recommendations” to “Requirements” under the User Safety Recommendations heading, and you must also replace the word, “should,”



For use in the following applications:

Paints, stains, latex emulsions, aqueous metalworking, cuttings, cooling and lubricating fluids and concentrates, paper and paper coatings, plastics and plastics coatings, cordage, inks, wood preservatives, sapstain, building materials, adhesives, caulks, patching compounds, sealants, grouts, latex used in flooring adhesives or carpet backing, and for use in unregistered treated article intermediates that will be further manufactured.
