Preventol A12 II is intended for formulation into antimicrobial products for use in wood preservation, material preservation (leather, paints, coatings, caulks, adhesives), metal working fluids, pulp and paper mills. **FOR MATERIAL PROTECTION USES ONLY**

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool, dry place.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Pesticide wastes may be acutely hazardous. Improper disposal is a violation of federal law. Repeat this procedure two more times.
