**CAUTION**

Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing of spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Avoid contamination of food and foodstuffs. Do not use in edible product areas of food processing plants, restaurants or other areas where food is commercially prepared or processed. Do not use in serving areas while food is exposed. Pets should be removed and fish aquariums and house plants covered or removed before treatment.

IF INHALED - Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

IF ON SKIN - Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water.

IF IN EYES - Flush eyes for at least 15 minutes with water. Call a physician immediately.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents Under Pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Use at least one can for each 10,000 cubic feet of unobstructed space. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured.

Locate fogger in center of room or area being treated. Place newspapers under fogger unit and for 3 or 4 feet around the can to prevent staining or marring of surfaces. Close doors and windows. Remove pets. Cover exposed foods and dishes. Open cabinets and doors to areas being treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all open flames except pilot light. Place at least 6 feet away from pilot light. Keep at arms length when releasing. Point top of can away from face and eyes. To start fogging action, press plastic tab on valve down until it clicks. Set in upright position and leave the building at once. Leave undisturbed for 2 hours. Open doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes.

Solvents may soften some asphalt or synthetic tile floors. If used directly over asphalt or synthetic tile, newspaper should be spread on the floor for several feet around the area of release. Do not use with freshly waxed floors; allow wax to become hardened. Some plastics may be affected. Remove or cover plastic items such as eyeglasses, stereo covers, notion boxes.

**DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.
