

BLANCO MULTI-KILL RESIDUAL FORMULA 2

KILLS Houseflies, mosquitoes, gnats, wasps, roaches, earwigs, grain mites, sowbugs, spiders, centipedes, ants, biting flies, aphids (plant lice), leafhoppers, exposed thrips, adult whiteflies, plant bugs, Japanese beetles, spittlebugs.

DOUBLE ACTION INSECT KILLER. This is a dual purpose formulation that can be used as a contact spray against flying and crawling insects and as a residual insecticide providing up to 3 to 4 weeks control of roaches.

For use in non food areas in homes, motels, institutions, restaurants and food processing plants.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid contact with eyes. Avoid breathing vapor or removing vapors. Avoid contact with food. Avoid contact with food preparation surfaces. Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Avoid contamination of food and food stuffs. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment and thoroughly cleaned before using. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is in operation in case of contact immediately flush eyes with plenty of water for at least 15 minutes. PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not store near heat or open flame. Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash. Do not throw container into fire or incinerator.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

This is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. **SHAKE WELL BEFORE EACH USE.** Remove protective cap, aim spray opening away from person. Push button to spray.

TO KILL HOUSEFLIES, MOSQUITOES AND GNATS INDOORS: See also label directions for use. From 12 to 24 inches, direct the spray at various parts of the room, especially windows and other light sources which attract these insects. Exit the room within 10 minutes of the treated area. Keep the room closed for at least 15 minutes, ventilate the room when treatment is completed.

TO REDUCE ANNOYANCE FROM FLYING INSECTS OUTDOORS: Reduce mosquitoes, gnats, earwigs, houseflies, deer flies and flying moths, midges by spraying their resting areas. Follow directions listed above. Hold container 18 to 24 inches from shrubs, bushes and grassy areas. Spray these areas with a slow sweeping motion at the rate of from 1 to 3 seconds per cubic foot of area while moving away from the treated area. To reduce annoyance from these flying insects, treat pet enclosures and pet cages in a similar manner. Spray only when the air is still. Allow spray to dry before allowing the treated area. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ROACHES, EARWIGS, GRAIN MITES, SOWBUGS, SPIDERS AND CENTIPEDES: **CONTACT SPRAY:** Spray thoroughly into hiding places such as cracks, crevices, under doors, under and around pipes and sinks, under refrigerators, baseboards and storage areas. Spray directly on insects where possible. Repeat as necessary.

RESIDUAL SPRAY: Spray baseboards, cracks, crevices, around and under wall outlets and other hiding places such as closets, under beds, under appliances, under and around doors. The active ingredient in these treatments spray, 1 to 2 inches in cracks and crevices, under walls, baseboards, under pipes and 1 to 4 seconds per linear foot at a distance of 12 to 14 inches from the surface. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL WASPS: Applications should be made in the late evening when the wasps are at rest. Spray the nesting and breeding places, contacting as many insects as possible. Repeat as necessary.

TO KILL ANTS: Apply to ant trails a distance of 10 to 15 inches from the trail in places where ants travel.

DOMESTIC PLANT PESTS: This spray is effective against leaf miners, plant bugs, Japanese beetles, smaller evergreen beetles, scales and aphids as well as other insects which injure plants, roses, arbutus, etc. Apply to plants and shrubs. Avoid spraying on plants which have been treated with other insecticides. Also, do not spray on plants which are in bloom.

HOUSEPLANTS: Apply to plants which are infested with plant bugs, spittlebugs, Japanese beetles, etc. on flowering plants such as geraniums, etc. Also, apply to plants which are infested with insects.

TO KILL SPIDERS: Apply to spider webs and other places where spiders are found. Spray directly on spider webs and other places where spiders are found. Repeat as necessary.
