

- Mix the fogger oil and water in the ratio of 1 part oil to 4 parts water. Apply to plants and soil surface. Avoid fogging any part of the cage. Apply to the soil surface at 100-150 g/litre of water. Repeat application when there is a new wave of infestation. Apply to soil surface 3m before and 3m after the treated area. Apply to the soil surface in the treated area and spread down on the outer boundary of the area and for 10m distance. Repeat application approximately the same.
- Under the above conditions the fog will be present in the treated area for a longer time. Apply fog while moving away from treated area. Avoid inhalation of the fog. Do not enter the treated area until the fog has dissipated. Repeat application as necessary.

not apply while food processing is underway. After space spraying in food processing plants, wash with potable water all equipment, benches, shelving, etc., where exposed food will be handled. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use.

Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

- c. Refer to the enclosed "Pesticide & Container Disposal Sheet" for the appropriate wording.
- d. In the environmental hazards statement, delete the phrase pertaining to lakes, streams, and ponds and add the phrase "DO NOT APPLY DIRECTLY TO WATER" in its place.
- e. *Label must state under horse stables. Not to use if horses are to be used for milk.*
3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 5(e). Your release for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

Your Letter of August 26, 1982

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(7)(A), is acceptable, provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA sec. 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.

2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:

- a. Refer to our letter of August 11, 1982, Comment A.
- b. This product contains a high amount of petroleum distillate. A statement of practical treatment for accidental ingestion is required. Consider a statement instructing that a physician be consulted in case of ingestion and directing that vomiting not be induced unless directed by a physician. A statement should be included that aspiration is a potential hazard.

In light of this information, the precautionary statement should be revised to read something like the following:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin.
Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately.
