




**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS

CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. In case of eye contact, immediately flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Remove and wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash thoroughly after handling.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARDS

Do not apply directly to any body of water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. Do not let the liquid come in contact with susceptible plants, such as vegetables, flowers, fruit trees, ornamentals, cotton, grasses, or other desirable plants or allow spray mists to drift onto these plants. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Thoroughly clean spray equipment before using for other purposes. Do not apply to areas underlain by roots of desirable trees and shrubs.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal Law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling

General Weed Control--Weed Killer Concentrate can be used to control most weeds for an extended period of time on non-cropland areas such as loading ramps, fence rows, railroad sidings, storage yards, parking lots, around buildings and industrial plant sites

To control annual weeds and grasses such as foxtail, ryegrass, wildoats, crabgrass, cheatgrass, broomsedge, ragweeds, lambsquarter and turkey mullein, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply 5 gallons of the diluted spray, per 1,000 square feet

For hard to kill perennial weeds and grasses such as johnson grass, salt grass, bouncing bet, bracken fern, horsetail, smooth broome, canada bluegrass, purple-top quackgrass, broomsedge, aster dandelion, dog fennel, goldenrod, plantain and wild carrot, dilute one gallon of concentrate to 9 gallons of water and apply 10 gallons of diluted spray per 1,000 square feet

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL Pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to Federal, State or local procedures under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act

CONTAINER DISPOSAL Triple rinse (or equivalent) and offer for recycling or reconditioning, or dispose of in a sanitary landfill or by other approved State and local procedures
