Your submission dated June 26, 1998

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under FIFRA section 3(c)(7)(a), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit and/or cite all data or other material required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) or FIFRA section 4 when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
 - a. Revise the **Environmental Hazards** to read as follows:

This pesticide is toxic to fish, birds, and other wildlife. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into lakes, streams, ponds, estuaries, oceans, or other waters unless in accordance with the requirements of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit and the permitting authority has been notified in writing prior to discharge. Do not discharge effluent containing this product into sewer systems without previously notifying the sewage treatment plant authority. For Guidance contact your State Water Board or Regional Office of the EPA.

3. Submit three (3) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the label is enclosed for your records.

The Agency has received your request dated October 2, 1998 to amend the label further by deleting the use on stored timber and lumber in industrial wood-processing facilities and deleting the use on dogs. Once the FIFRA Section 6(f)(1) Notice for those use deletions has been published and the requested 30-day comment period has passed, the Agency will accept that requested amendment.

- Treatment of seeds for the following agricultural crops: barley, broccoli, Brussels sprouts, cabbage, cauliflower, celery, collards, corn, lettuce, kale, kohlrabi, mustard greens, oats, radishes, rye, sorghum, spinach, Swiss chard, and wheat
- Treatment of stored timber and lumber in industrial wood-processing facilities - use in the open forest is prohibited
- Treatment of dogs to control fleas, ticks, lice, ear mites, sarcoptic mange mites, and scabies (psoroptic) mange mites

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Storage: If container is damaged: Stop any leaks by repositioning the container or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Sweep on to a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below.
