
3. Submit five (5) copies of the final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment. Refer to the A-79 Enclosure for a further description of final printed labeling.

2. When drinking water is desired, remove filter from container and screw onto canteen in place of cap.

3. Place a finger over the small air hole at base of filter, place the mouth piece into your mouth and tip the canteen into pouring position, suck water from canteen. Removing finger from air hole will let water flow faster. A slight dripping from threads between canteen and filter is normal.

4. Water for cooking may be obtained in the same manner, merely let it run into cooking container.

5. When not in use, store filter in container.
