3. Delete the statement, "This product is designed for use with iodine to kill bacteria, viruses, and parasites in untreated water and for filtration of suspended solids" from the product labeling.
4. The phrase "Use with cold water only" must appear on the product labeling.
5. The following statement; "Improves the quality of untreated raw water in two ways, "must be deleted from the product labeling. The product was registered as a bacteriostatic water filter which is to be used only for filtration of municipally treated water.

A stamped copy of the product label is enclosed for your records.

Submit one copy of the final printed labeling before releasing the product in channels of trade with the revised labeling.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA sec. 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION: IT IS A VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW TO USE THIS PRODUCT IN A MANNER INCONSISTENT WITH ITS LABELING.

NOTE: All Argenion Bacteriostatic Water Treatment Units use the same Model-1 cartridge. The dash number (*Example:* Model-1-4) indicates the accessories, fittings, etc., supplied with each model for a specific application.

The Argenion Bacteriostatic Water Treatment Unit, Model 1 Cartridge has been designed to provide you with up to 10,000 gallons of crystal-clear, good-tasting, odor-free municipally treated tap water.

This unit is composed of oligodynamic silver which has been combined with activated carbon through a complex manufacturing technique so that the filter media will provide bacteriostatic activity within the filter unit, making the effective life of the unit much longer than an ordinary carbon filter. This product has been tested in private and government laboratories, and is designed for use with municipally treated tap water. The total life of **ARGENION Bacteriostatic Water Treatment Unit, Model 1 Cartridge** is up to 10,000 gallons depending on the condition of the municipally treated tap water.



WARRANTY: The Marketers International, Inc. warrants this product for twelve (12) months from date of purchase against defects in workmanship and parts. Proof of purchase is required. The limit of Marketers International, Inc. liability to our customers shall not exceed the cost of or replacement of our product. Relief under this warranty is given expressly in lieu of all other warranties expressed or implied and constitutes the only warranty made by The Marketers International, Inc.



CARTRIDGE REPLACEMENT: The Argenion cartridge is guaranteed to retain its bacteriostatic effectiveness for 10,000 gallons. Studies show that the average family of four will use approximately 2,000 gallons of water per year for drinking and cooking.

Depending on the condition of your municipally treated water, the cartridge may want to be replaced sooner for the elimination of chlorine, suspended solids, taste and odors.



BACK FLUSH INSTRUCTIONS: Suspended solids trapped from use may eventually cause a reduced flow rate. To clear this condition and assure longer filter life, reverse the direction of flow on cartridge and allow water to run to waste 15 minutes. Return filter cartridge connections to original position and run to waste 5 minutes.
