DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Read Entire Label.

For best results, spray in early morning or late evening when insect activity is minimal. Stand a safe distance from nest and not directly underneath. Remove protective cap. Hold can upright and point spray opening toward nest with wind at your back. Spray until nest is thoroughly saturated to kill the entire nest population. Residual action will kill wasps and hornets returning to the nest. Wait at least 24 hours before removing the nest.

To kill wasps, hornets, bees, and yellow jackets under eaves, screens, window frames, doors, patios, cracks, holes, or crevices wherever insects are noticed, spray for about 1-2 seconds or until surfaces are moist. To prevent entrance of insects into the building, spray around points where insects enter outside plumbing, faucets, and cracks or crevices in foundation as well as along sills and ledges. All outdoor applications must be limited to spot or crack-and-crevice treatments only. Do not apply more than 1 time per day. Do not water the treated area to the point of run-off. Do not make applications during rain.

Restrictions
