DIRECTIONS FOR SWIMMING POOLS:
For a new pool or for spring start-up, add 1 1/2 pints (16 fl. oz.) of sodium hypochlorite solution to 2500 gallons of water. This dosage will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine by weight.

FOR POOL MAINTENANCE:
A) Adjust pool water pH to 7.6.
B) Add manually or by a feed system at a rate to maintain a residual of 0.6 to 1.0 ppm. One half pint of sodium hypochlorite solution will provide 1.0 ppm available chlorine in 2500 gallons of water. Use test kit to make certain you are in the proper range.

NOTE: This product degrades with time and increases dosage, as necessary, to maintain the proper level of available chlorine.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:
Store in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight. In case of a spill, absorb with sawdust or other inert material, place in a container and either return to manufacturer for collection or burying in an appropriate site that cannot be used, should be disposed of in a sanitary sewer, or by storage, disposal or clean-up.
