

CHEM QUAT MINT 7

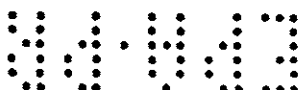
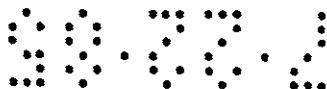
