Dear Ms. Bell:

The Agency has received your request of May 3, 2021 to revise Condition #4 of the registration notice referenced above. As noted in your letter, Degesch America, Inc. submitted a sample to the Ft. Meade laboratory, but due to the hazardous nature of aluminum phosphide, the laboratory was not able to safely accept and store the sample.

The proposed amendment to the registration notice referenced above, in connection with conditional registration of this product under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act, is acceptable. This approval revises the Condition #4 on the registration notice dated May 4, 2020. Condition #4 will be revised to read:

4. You are required to submit a sample of the analytical grade of the active ingredient upon request. The Analytical Chemistry Branch will contact you regarding the need/scheduling for submittal of the analytical method used to assay the active ingredient in the product, as needed.

This approval does not affect any other conditions imposed on this registration by the May 4, 2020 registration notice. You continue to be subject to existing conditions on your registration and any deadlines connected with them.
