The labeling referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act, as amended, is acceptable subject to the comments listed below. One copy of the finished labeling must be submitted prior to releasing the product for shipment.

Correct the spelling of "propy" in the ingredient statement to read "propyl".

Revise the sentence "Be free of flies is formulated for Horses" to read "Be free of flies is formulated for use on horses only"

Since this product is a liquid, amounts must be stated as fluid ounces.

Delete the sentence under the "If on skin or clothing" First Aid statement about removing contact lenses (but keep it under the "If in eyes" First Aid statement).

Under the Container Disposal statements, "triple rise" must be corrected to read "triple rinse".

B-FREE OF FLIES is formulated for Horses.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

B-FREE OF FLIES has been especially developed for use on animals. It provides a protective hair coating against flies, while imparting a high sheen to the hair when brushed out. Use one or two ounces per head per day, gives adequate protection. Apply by either a soft cloth or a fine mist spray.

USE AS A WIPE ON:

First, brush animal to remove excess dirt and dust. moisten (but do not wet to the point of dripping) a soft cloth and rub over the hair. It is best to apply by rubbing against the hair growth. Give special attention to the legs, shoulders, shanks, neck and facial areas where flies most often are seen. Only a light application is required. Avoid using an excessive amount on your animal. Do not wet skin. After application, brush out thoroughly to bring out bright sheen on the coat.

SPRAYING HORSES:

Do not wet skin of animals, or exceed two ounces per application. To control blood-surface lice, apply to the infested areas of the animal, using a stiff brush to get the spray to the base of the hair. B-FREE OF FLIES kills and repels Stable Flies, Horn Flies, House Flies, Face Flies, Horse Flies, Deer Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Ticks, Fleas and Lice. B-FREE OF FLIES is also a grooming aid and coat conditioner.

HAZARDS TO HUMAN**

Do not use on horses intended for slaughter.

CAUTION:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin.
Avoid contact with eyes and skin.

First Aid:

If on skin or clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison center or doctor for treatment advice.

If in eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison center or doctor for treatment. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Note to physician: Contains petroleum distillate - vomiting may cause aspiration pneumonia.
