PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS CAUTION

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. In case of contact, immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if irritation persists if swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Call a physician immediately. Do not apply directly to milk. Cover or remove any food and food processing equipment during application. Do not apply while food processing is under way. After space spraying in barns, poultry houses, warehouses, etc. wash thoroughly all facilities and equipment with an acceptable detergent solution and then rinse with potable water to remove all traces of contamination. All food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before use. Remove pets and birds, and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

This product is toxic to fish, birds and other wildlife. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by disposal of wastes. Apply this product only as specified on this label.

PHYSICAL HAZARDS

Do not use, or store near heat or open flame. Exposure to temperatures above 130°F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal. Open dumping is prohibited.

STORAGE: If container is damaged: STOP any leaks by repositioning the container or by patching or otherwise repairing the leaks. Take care to avoid contact with pesticide and wear protective gear. On cleanup of spilled liquids, wear protective equipment as required to prevent contact with the product or its vapors. Cover the spilled areas with generous amounts of absorbent material, such as clay, diatomaceous earth, sand or sawdust. Sweep the contaminated absorbent onto a shovel and put the sweepings into a salvage drum. Dispose of wastes as below. Place any leaking container into a similar drum or glass container. Do not store, use, pour or spill near heat or open flame.

PESTICIDE DISPOSAL: Wastes resulting from the use of this product may be disposed of on site or at an approved waste disposal facility.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: Triple rinse (or equivalent). Then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other procedures approved by state and local authorities.

For best results, use a good clean sprayer — free of rust — which produces a fine mist.

FOR FLYING INSECTS: Flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats and wasps: Close doors and windows. Spray freely towards ceiling in all directions until room is fogged with mist. When spraying, keep about 3 feet from interior walls, fabrics and furniture. Doors and windows may be opened after 10 minutes.

FOR CHAWLING INSECTS: Roaches, waterbugs, silverfish and crickets: Spray thoroughly into cracks and crevices, under and behind sinks, cupboards, drawers, woodwork, refrigerators, pipes and drains, where these insects hide. Spray directly on as many insects as possible. Repeat application as necessary.

For the control of flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats, wasps, roaches, waterbugs, silverfish, crickets, carpet beetles, bedbugs, ants, and fleas.
