DIRECTIONS FOR USE - General Use Concentrate - designed for use undiluted in mechanical sprayers which give particle size of aerosol size, such as ULV equipment. It can be diluted with refined kerosenes which meet FDA Reg. 21CFR 172.884 and can be applied in fogging equipment that gives larger than aerosol particle size. It can be also diluted with oil specified above and applied as a contact spray to kill crawling insects shown later on this label.

Space Spray - Undiluted in ^{ULV} Aerosol Generators - to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Apply at the rate of 1 oz. of undiluted Concentrate per 1000 cu. ft. of space. Direct output from aerosol generator upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

Space Spray - Diluted for Ordinary Mechanical Fogging Equipment - to Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Gnats: Cover or remove exposed food and food handling surfaces. Close room and shut off all air conditioning or ventilating equipment. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 19 parts of oil and mix well. Apply at the rate of 50 fl. oz. dilute spray (0.1 gal.) per 25,000 cu. ft. of space. Direct fog upward towards upper corners of room and ceiling area. Leave room closed for 1/2 hour. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry.

NOTE: This spray, when applied per the directions and cautions above, conforms with Food Additive Regulations 193.320, 193.360 and 191.340 and the food additive tolerances established thereunder.

Contact Spray - Diluted for Use with Sprayers that Give Large, Wetting Spray Particles to Kill Cockroaches and Accessible Stages of Granary Insects - Granary Weevils, Rice Weevils, Confused Flour Beetles, Red Flour Beetles, Meal Moth Larvae and Adults, Caddises, Grain Mites and Saw Toothed Grain Beetles: Cover or remove exposed food and close room as described above. Dilute Concentrate with oil at the rate of 1 part Concentrate plus 20 parts of oil and mix well. Spray outside walls of granary, flooring about base of milling machinery, walls and baseboards, areas behind cabinets, around pipes and other insect harborages using 1 gal. spray per 1000 sq. ft. of space. Force spray into all cracks and crevices. Repeat applications as necessary.

Contact and Space Spray - Undiluted - to Kill Cockroaches, Silverfish, Earwigs, Ants, Spiders, in Sheltered Situations. With U.V. spraying device, apply the spray into all cracks and crevices in woodwork, walls, floors, underneath sinks, behind pipes and in all places where these insects shelter. Contact as many insects as possible. Do not allow spray to contact stored food. Use at a dosage rate of approximately 1/2 fl. oz. per 1000 cu. ft. of room space. Repeat dosage as necessary for control. Leave the room closed for one hour. Do not remain in treated areas and ventilate area before re entry. Do not apply this undiluted spray in facilities operating under USDA poultry, meat, rabbit and egg products inspection program.

CAUTION KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Harmful if swallowed. Food should be removed or covered during treatment. All food processing surfaces should be covered during treatment or thoroughly cleaned before use. When using the product in these areas, apply only when the facility is not in operation. Do not breathe spray mist. Wear mask or respirator of a type recommended by the U.S. Bureau of Mines to give adequate protection against this material. Wear protective clothing. Wash hands, and face with soap and water after handling and before eating or smoking. Wash all contaminated clothing with soap and water before re-use. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse or equivalent then offer for recycling or reconditioning, or puncture and dispose of in a sanitary landfill, or by other State and local procedure.

Pesticide Disposal: Pesticide spray or rinse water that cannot be used according to label instructions must be disposed of according to applicable Federal, State or local procedure.
