### DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Formula 912 is used to control algae and fungi in recirculating commercial and industrial water systems. To its use, systems must be cleaned to remove algal growth, slimes, and other deposits. An initial slug addition of 6 fluid ounces of Formula 912

of water to provide a concentration of 48 to 120 Formula 912

per 1000 gallons of water, based on the volume of water in the system, is recommended. Repeat initial dosage until control is evident.

Subsequent slug additions of 1.53 to 15 Formula 912

per 1000 gallons of water should be employed every 2 to 5 days, or as needed. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the problem. Slug additions should be made in the sump of water collection trays of the airwash system.

Formula 912 is used to control bacteria in air-washing systems that maintain effective mist eliminators. To its use, systems should be cleaned to remove bacterial deposits. An initial slug dose of 24.7 to 41.2 Formula 912

per 1000 gallons of water should be employed each 1 to 5 days. The frequency of addition depends upon the relative amount of bleedoff and the severity of the bacterial problem. Slug additions may be made to the sump of water collection trays of the airwash system.
