

PARANITROPHENOL, TECHNICAL

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to humans and domestic animals.

DANGER Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and face shield and rubber gloves when handling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. Prohibitions

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Open dumping is prohibited

Do not reuse empty container

2. Pesticide Disposal

Fungicide or insecticide that cannot be used or chemically reprocessed should be disposed of in a landfill approved for pesticides, or buried in a safe place away from water supplies.

3. Container Disposal

Triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill or bury in a safe place

4. General

Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning

Exclusively registered for use as a fungicide to be incorporated in cork insulation or leather for military use at a concentration not to exceed 0.7% on a basis of dry finished cork or leather weight.
