

PARANITROPHENOL, TECHNICAL

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS Hazards to humans and domestic animals.

DANGER Corrosive, causes eye and skin damage. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. Wear goggles and face shield and rubber gloves when handling. May be fatal if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe vapors. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

1. Prohibitions

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Open dumping is prohibited
Do not reuse empty container

2. Pesticide Disposal

Pesticide wastes are toxic. Improper disposal of excess pesticide, spray mixture or rinsate is a violation of Federal law. If these wastes cannot be disposed of by use according to label instructions, contact your State Pesticide or Environmental Control Agency, or the Hazardous Waste representative at the nearest EPA Regional Office for guidance.

3. Container Disposal

Triple rinse and offer for recycling, reconditioning or disposal in approved landfill.

4. General

Consult Federal, State or local disposal authorities for approved alternative procedures such as limited open burning.

Exclusively registered for use as a fungicide to be incorporated in cork insulation or leather for military use at a concentration not to exceed 0.7% on a basis of dry finished cork or leather weight.

FIRST AID:

To be added to a running drum or mixer during or immediately after the re-tanning, coloring, and fat liquoring operation; to the soaking tanks containing cut insoles during the chrome re-tanning of vegetable tanned insoles or to butyl impregnating solution which is to be used to treat vegetable tanned cut outsoles.

Directions for use of PNP in cork insulation

Application is to be made in accordance with established Air Force procedures contained in the Roeling Company Process Specification BAC 5472 (Bonding Cork-Composition Ablative Insulation Material.)
