The following amendment, submitted in connection with registration under the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable with conditions.

- Update "First Aid" statements per PR Notice 2001-1
- Update "Storage & Disposal" statement per PR Notice 2001-6.

Conditions

1. Move the signal word "Warning" beneath Ingredient statement.
2. Add the phrase "Keep Out of Reach of Children"
3. Correct the Precautionary Statement to read "**Hazards To Humans and Domestic Animals.**"
4. Add the following phrase: This product is to be used only for short term use. Extended use can cause adverse health effects. It must appear in bold type in a font no less than the precautionary statement.

2. Replace canteen cap loosely. Wait 5 minutes and shake well, allowing leakage.
3. Tighten cap. Wait an additional thirty minutes before using for any purpose.
