**DIRECTIONS FOR SANITIZING FOOD PROCESSING OR DAIRY EQUIPMENT**

1. Add to food processing or dairy equipment. Chlorine will be released slowly over a period of time. Chlorine is effective against bacteria, algae, and other organisms that cause swimming pool problems. Chlorine is also effective against certain types of fungi.

**NOTE:** Do not add chlorine to swimming pools containing vinyl liner or vinyl tile. Do not use chlorine on vinyl tile.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:**

1. Store in a dry place away from children and pets. Do not store near strong acids or bases.

2. Do not dispose of this product in regular trash. Do not pour it down storm drains or sewers.
