C A U T I O N

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Feed HI-CUSTOM ROL .29 at the rate of 1/2 lb. per 100 lbs. of body weight per day by mixing it into the ground grain or complete dairy ration.

Start feeding HI-CUSTOM ROL .29 early in the spring before flies begin to appear and continue feeding through out the summer into the fall until cold weather restricts fly activity.

HI-CUSTOM ROL .29 may be fed up to lactating and to lactating dairy cows.

HI-CUSTOM ROL .29 prevents the development of horn flies, face flies, house flies and stable flies in the manure of treated cattle, but it is not effective against existing adult flies. When starting a feeding program during the fly season, it is desirable to use other control measures to reduce the population of existing adult flies.

In some cases, supplemental fly control measure may be needed in and around cattle lots and buildings to control adult house flies and stable flies which can breed not only in cattle manure but in other decaying vegetable matter or silage on the premises.

In order to achieve optimum fly control, HI-CUSTOM ROL .29 should be used in conjunction with other feed mixing, manure and sanitation practices.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storing or handling.

Precipitated, spray mixture, or rinsed water that cannot be used according to label instructions or disposed of according to applicable federal, state, or local regulations.

- Care should be taken to completely mix by shaking container, add and bottle or bag remaining material, empty residue into a suitable container. This product of use in manure should only be incinerated if licensed by State and Local authorities.
