APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS Use the recommended rate of 2,4-D in sufficient water to cover one acre...

SMALL GRAINS (WHEAT, BARLEY, RYE, OATS) Winter Wheat and Rye: Treat only in the Spring. Use 1 to 2 pints in sufficient water to cover one acre...

Spring Wheat, Oats and Barley: Use 1 to 2 pints/acre for annual broadleaf weeds and up to 3 pints per acre for perennial weeds...

CORN (Post Emergence): May be applied at several stages of growth. Use drop nozzles when corn is 10 inches or over...

Early Spraying: Corn is 2-4 inches high. Apply as soon as possible after most weeds have emerged...

Lay By Spraying: Corn is 2-3 ft high. Use drop nozzles. At this stage of growth since stalks may become brittle from 2,4-D...

High Clearance Spraying: This spray is especially useful when weeds get started after lay by. Use 1 1/2 pints/acre...

SORGHUM (Post Emergence ONLY): Use drop nozzles. Sorghums are most tolerant to 2,4-D. Apply at 10-12 inches high...

HARD TO KILL WEEDS in NON-CROPLAND: For perennial weeds such as Sown Pasture Grass, etc. See label for directions...

PASTURES AND TURF: Apply this spray to pastures and lawns. Apply early in summer when weeds are young...
