Directions for Use

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product shoots a powerful spray blast. A test firing is recommended to acquaint the user with the spray pattern before using on wasps and hornets.

Do not use on plastic, foam, asphalt roofing shingles or auto paint. Damage may occur.

For outdoor use: Can also be used in attics, warehouses and other storage areas where foods and foodstuffs are not present. Kills Hornets, Wasps, Yellow Jackets and Bees, outdoors.

For Outdoor Use: Application should be made when insects are at rest. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. With wind at back, aim at nests under eaves, chimneys, cracks or crevices, telephone and power lines.

Storage: Store in a cool dry area (inaccessible to children and pets), away from heat or open flame.

Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in newspaper and put in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Food should be removed or covered during treatment.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if warranted.

IF IN EYES: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF ON SKIN: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and thoroughly wash skin with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

IF SWALLOWED: Immediately contact a physician or Poison Control Center. Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS
