BACK PANEL - Enforcer Room Fogger

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Cover exposed foods, dishes and food handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

TO OPERATE VALVE: To prevent damage to wood surfaces or floors, place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table (in center of room) with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying. Repeat treatment in two weeks or when necessary.

TO KILL BROWN DOG TICKS: Remove and destroy all pet bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, windows and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Put fresh bedding in pets quarters after spray has dried. Also treat dogs and cats with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter treated area.

TO KILL FLEAS: Follow the directions for ticks, but use one can per 1,500 cubic feet.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or other sources of ignition. **Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes or clothing. Avoid breathing vapors. Wash thoroughly with soap and warm water after handling.

Do not use in commercial food processing preparation, storage or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Avoid contamination of food and feed stuffs. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquaria before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard. Contact a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. **If On Skin:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area of skin with soap and warm water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse. **If In Eyes:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if necessary.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Flammable. Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Do not smoke while using this product. Turn off pilot lights in gas appliances in the use area. After airing out phase is completed, relight pilot lights. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130° F may cause bursting. Incineration of container may cause explosion.
