Harmful if swallowed, inhaled or absorbed through the skin. Avoid breathing vapors. Avoid contact with skin or clothing. Do not use in commercial food processing storage, preparation or serving areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed with a suitable cleaning compound followed by a potable water rinse before use. STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If Swallowed: Immediately contact a physician or poison control center. Do not induce vomiting due to aspiration hazard. If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if warranted. If On Skin: Immediately remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with plenty of water. SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CAN UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

INDOORS: To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths, Gnats and Wasps: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests such as Aphids, Leafhoppers, Lacebugs, Whiteflies, Spiders, Mites, Japanese Beetles, Mealy Bugs, Caterpillars, Box Elder Bugs, & Eastern Tent Caterpillars: General: When sprayed directly in insects, this spray will kill the insects listed. Caution should be taken when spraying new tender growth on young plants.

WHEN SPRAYING, HOLD CAN 18-24 INCHES FROM PLANT.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Mist the plants lightly. Use a slow sweeping motion. Avoid wetting foliage with spray. Spray

rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90 F.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or other sources of ignition. Disposal: Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
