To Kill Yellow Jackets: Yellow jackets make their nests in the ground, dead tree stumps, railroad trestles or similar structures. During daylight hours, look closely to determine location of nest entrance. Wait until dusk or early morning when insects are at rest. Empty canke can down hole from a close enough distance to deposit cloud of spray in hole. When used to kill wasps, hornets and other insects, do not use inside the home.
