The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the tetramethrin and sumithrin REDs, and has concluded that your submission is acceptable.

NOTE: This product is <u>not</u> being reregistered under sections 3(c)5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time.

Please be reminded that 40 CFR Part 156.140(a)(4) requires that a batch code, lot number, or other code identifying the batch of the pesticide distributed and sold be placed on non-refillable containers. The code may appear either on the label or durably marked on the container itself, and can be added by non-notification per PRN 98-10.

Please note that the record for this product currently contains the Confidential Statements of Formulation (CSFs) listed below. Any CSFs other than those listed below are superseded.

average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Thoroughly ventilate room before re-entry. Keep pets out of room until product has dried. Sweep up and throw away fallen insects.

OUTDOORS

[Fast Acting Protecting Covering Blanketing

Shake twice only before using. Hold can upright. Apply in short bursts. [Do not use inside the home.] Do not use on plastic, foam, asphalt roofing shingles, vinyl siding or auto paint. Damage may occur.

Vinyl Siding – Please Read Carefully: Enforcer House & Garden Bug Killer is a water based product. During spray application to nest, if inadvertent contact to vinyl siding occurs, rinse immediately with water.

To Kill Ornamental Plant Pests such as Aphids, Leafhoppers, Lacebugs, Whiteflies, Spiders, Mites, Japanese Beetles, Asian Lady Beetles, Mealy Bugs, Caterpillars, Box Elder Bugs and Eastern Tent Caterpillars: General: When sprayed directly on insects, this spray will kill the listed insects. Exercise caution when spraying new tender growth on young plants.

When spraying, hold can 18-24 inches from plant.

For best results, spray in the evening or on a cloudy day when air is still. Do not spray when temperatures exceed 90° F. Lightly mist the plants, using a slow sweeping motion. Do not wet foliage with spray. If spray accidentally contacts foliage or siding, immediately wash with water. Spray rows at the rate of 1 foot per second. For heavy growth, spray both sides of row. Repeat as needed.

To Kill Wasps: Apply at dusk or early morning when insects are least active. Hold can upright. Point valve opening away from face. With wind at back, aim at nests in trees, bushes, under eaves, chimneys, cracks or crevices.

To Kill Yellow Jackets: Yellow Jackets make their nests in the ground, dead tree stumps, railroad ties, walls or similar structures. During daylight hours, watch them closely to determine location of nest entrance. Wait until dusk or early morning when insects are at rest. Spray entire can down hole from a close enough distance to direct 100% of spray into hole.

To Kill Hornets: Unless you can clearly see the opening at the bottom of the hornets' nest, never use a hornet spray (on the nest) as hornets may escape and attack you. Hornets usually make their nests in trees, shrubs and under eaves. During daylight hours, determine location of nest entrance. Wait until dusk or early morning when insects are at rest. Direct form spray into entrance hole. As hornets fall out continue spraying until no more are visible or the can is empty. Immediately leave area.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat,

open flame or other sources of ignition. Do not incinerate or puncture!

DISPOSAL: Nonrefillable container. Do not reuse or refill this container. Offer for recycling, if available.
