Amendment - Company Name Change/General Label Revision  
Enforcer Four Hour Fogger  
EPA Registration No. 40849-11  
Your Letter Dated December 9, 1985

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3(c)(7)(A) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), is acceptable provided that you:

1. Submit/cite all data required for registration/reregistration of your product under FIFRA section 3(c)(5) when the Agency requires all registrants of similar products to submit such data.
2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment bearing the amended labeling:
  - a. On the front label you use the term "Preadult Fleas." You must be more specific as there are a number of stages which could fall into this category. As you are aware, this type of claim must be supported by data.
  - b. Please revise your active ingredients statement as follows:
    - (1) ". . . -3-(2-methylpropenyl) . . . ."
    - (2) ". . . methyl-4-chloro . . . ."
  - c. The child hazard warning, "Keep Out of Reach of Children," must precede the signal word "CAUTION." We suggest that they appear on separate lines.

d. Any reference to "general use" classification must be removed from (the <sup>your</sup> ~~product's name~~ <sup>product</sup>)'s labeling. "General Use" as a classification is no longer deemed valid by the Agency, even when products are not subject to restricted use as in the case of (product name). If a product is classified for restricted use, this classification notifies individuals that the chemical may be applied only by or under the direct supervision of a certified applicator. The absence of a restricted use classification clearly implies that the aforementioned restriction does not apply to a particular pesticide or its uses. A second classification for general use is thereby unnecessary and should not appear on ~~product~~ <sup>your product</sup> ~~name's~~ labeling.

e. Under the subwording "To Kill Ticks and Fleas," delete the wording "EPA Registered."

f. Under the Statement of Practical Treatment section add the following subheading and wording:

IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air.  
Apply artificial respiration if indicated.

g. Please revise the first paragraph of the Precautionary Statements section to read:

Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. May cause eye irritation. Avoid contact with skin, eyes, or clothing. Avoid contamination of food and feedstuffs.

We have noted the company name and address change from C and J Chemical, Inc., P.O. Box 337, Marietta, GA 30061 to Enforcer Products, Inc., P.O. Box 1068, Cartersville, GA 30120. This change will become part of our official records.

3. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release

for shipment of the product bearing the amended labeling constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

A stamped copy of the labeling is enclosed for your records.

## FOUR HOUR FOGGER

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE. GENERAL CLASSIFICATION.

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

**STORAGE AND DISPOSAL:** Storage: Store in a cool, dry area away from heat or open flame. Disposal: Do not reuse container. Wrap container and put in trash collection.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets, and Black Widow Spiders.

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close door and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote rooms or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** To lock valve in open position for automatic discharge, press valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table in the center of the room with valve locked open, placing several layers of newspaper or pad under fogger. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat spraying in two weeks or when necessary.

To kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy or replace pet bedding and replace. Use product as above. Do not use this product on pets. Treat with EPA-Registered ENFORCER® flea & tick control product bearing directions for direct application.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT: IF SWALLOWED:** Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard. Get medical attention. IF ON SKIN: Wash off with soap and water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists.

**PHYSICAL HAZARDS:** Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperature above 130° may cause bursting. Solvents may cause damage to some plastics. Use with caution.
