TO KILL: FLEAS AND TICKS

1. Use 4 oz. for each 100 square feet of carpet to be treated.
2. Sprinkle Flea Killer for Carpets lightly over carpeted area by shaking container from side to side. For best results, drive the powder deep into the carpet by brushing lightly with a broom.
3. Wait one hour, vacuum as usual. Remove bag from vacuum, wrap, put in trash collection. Two or three hours may be required for severe infestation. Make sure carpet is dry before using. Do not allow powder to become wet.
