DIRECTIONS FOR USE GENERAL CLASSIFICATION

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL: **Storage:** Store in a cool area away from heat or open flame

Disposal: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container and put in trash collection

Shake before use. Hold container upright. Apply in short bursts

To Kill Flies, Mosquitoes, Gnats, Wasps, Hornets, Sandflies, Flying Moths: Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a low, sweeping motion. Spray 5 to 10 seconds for average room (1,000 cubic feet). Keep nozzle three feet from surfaces. Vacate premises. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry

Precautionary Statements: Hazards to Humans and Domestic Animals.

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist. Avoid contact with skin. In case of contact, immediately flush skin with plenty of water.

When used in commercial food processing, storage, preparation or serving areas, or in the house, all processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment, or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Do not apply while processing, preparation, or serving is underway. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying
