**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS
HAZARDS TO HUMANS & DOMESTIC ANIMALS**

WARNING: Causes skin irritation. Harmful if swallowed. Avoid breathing vapors. May cause eye irritation. Do not get on skin, in eyes, or on clothing. Do not spray plants used for food or feed.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If On Skin: Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area thoroughly with soap and water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to re-use.

If Swallowed: Immediately call a physician or Poison Control Center at once. Do not induce vomiting because of aspiration hazard.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if necessary.

If In Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Do not use or store near heat or open flame.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

[For products packaged with a hose-end sprayer attachment the following paragraphs will be used:]

LAWN FLEA CONTROL:

1. Attach siphonage tube to hose-end sprayer attachment.
2. Screw hose into hose-end sprayer attachment.
3. Remove cap from bottle and insert sprayer attachment.
4. Securely tighten sprayer attachment onto bottle.
5. Turn water on. TO START FLOW OF INSECTICIDE, place finger over hole on the right side of sprayer attachment.
6. TO STOP FLOW OF INSECTICIDE, remove finger from over hole to break siphon action.

To kill fleas harboring in lawns and ensure adequate coverage, use moderate to high water pressure when applying through hose-end sprayer attachment. Apply at a rate of 1 pint to cover 6,000 square feet (1 quart to cover 12,000 square feet). For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets

will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS:

To control on contact cockroaches, palmetto bugs, ants, crickets, sowbugs, spiders and ticks: Apply at a rate of 1 pint to cover 1,000 square feet (1 quart to cover 2,000 square feet) to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct heat or sunlight.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container or hose-end sprayer attachment. Wrap container and hose-end sprayer attachment in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash.

[For products packaged without a hose-end sprayer attachment, the following paragraphs will be used:]

LAWN FLEA CONTROL:

To kill fleas harboring in lawns use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place 4 fluid ounces of concentrate in a sprayer jar and fill to the 9 gallon water mark to treat 1,500 sq. ft. (50' X 30'). Mix well. Attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where the pets will normally frequent. Spray under ornamentals and trees, but avoid soaking young or flowering plants. Repeat treatments may be necessary at 7 to 14 day intervals.

Keep pets and children out of the treated area until after the spray has dried. Do not spray animals. Dogs, cats, their kennel or bedding area should also be treated with a registered flea control product in conjunction with this application.

NOTE: 1 fluid ounce = 2 tablespoonsful = 6 teaspoonsful.

FOR OUTDOOR PESTS:

Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of 16 fluid ounces per 1 gallon of water to control on contact cockroaches, palmetto bugs, ants, crickets, sowbugs, spiders and ticks. Use at the rate of 1 gallon (diluted spray) per 1,000 square feet to outside surfaces of buildings, porches, patios, garages and other areas where these pests have been seen or are found. Do not spray in or near fish ponds or other bodies of water. Do not allow spray to contact ornamental plants or shrubs because of possible injury.

BUILDING PERIMETER TREATMENT:

To help prevent infestations of buildings by ants, crickets, spiders, centipedes and sowbugs (pillbugs), treat a 12-18 inch band of soil or other substrate adjacent to buildings and the building foundation to a height of 2 to 3 feet where these pests are active and may find entrance. Use 4 fluid ounces of concentrate per gallon of water and apply as a coarse wet spray at the rate of 1 gallon per 1,000 square feet.

STORAGE: Store in original container in a cool dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct heat or sunlight.

DISPOSAL: Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash collection.
