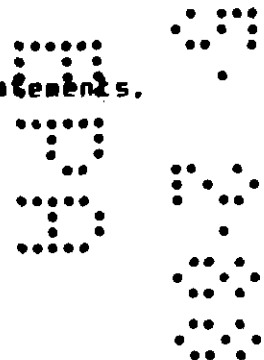

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

If in Eyes: Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists. **If on Skin:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area of skin with soap and warm water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse. **If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if necessary. **If Swallowed:** Do not induce vomiting. Aspiration is a hazard. Call a physician immediately.

PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near fire, sparks or heated surfaces. Do not smoke while using this product. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

FOR SPACE SPRAY

To Kill flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats and wasps: Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To kill cockroaches, ants and crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, Saw-toothed grain beetles and rice weevils: Find and destroy infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects
