Enforcer Ant & Roach Killer III

Your Submission Dated March 3, 2003

Dear Ms. Hawkes:

The amendment referred to above, submitted in connection with registration under section 3 (c)(5) of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, is acceptable, subject to the comments listed below.

1. Under the Precautionary Statements section of the label, move the following statements to the Directions for Use section: "Do not use in ...spray has dried." Delete the word "May" at the beginning of this section. Revise the statement "Avoid breathing spray..." to read "Avoid breathing vapor or spray mist". Move the statement "...provide adequate ventilation of area being treated" to the Directions for Use section.
2. Either delete the phrases "Repeat as necessary" and "Repeat treatment when necessary" or indicate a time period based on the residual efficacy of your product.
3. Add the following statement to the end of the "Brown Dogs Ticks and Fleas" section: "Also, treat your yard with a product registered for yard application."
4. Add the following precaution to the paragraph under Flies and Mosquitoes "Remove all exposed food and cooking utensils. Cover all food handling surfaces or wash thoroughly after treatment and before use. Do not use on edible crops. Hold can two (2) to three (3) feet from surface to be treated and spray in infested surface of patio or picnic area, hitting as many insects as possible. Spray to slightly moisten the surface."
5. Add the following statements to the Directions for Use section "Do not apply in classrooms when in use. Do not apply this product in occupied patient rooms or in any

rooms/areas while occupied by patients, the elderly or infirm. Do not apply to institutions (including libraries, sports facilities, etc.) in the immediate area when occupants are present."

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

For Spot Treatment

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Spiders, Sowbugs, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Spray areas where these pests are found or may hide, including dark corners of rooms and closets; cracks and crevices in walls; along baseboards and door and window frames; behind and beneath sinks, stoves, refrigerators and cabinets; and around garbage cans, plumbing and other utility installations. Directly spray pests driven out of hiding places. For ants, apply to ant trails, also around doors and windows and wherever else these pests may find entrance. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Thoroughly apply as a spot treatment to infested area such as pet beds and resting quarters; nearby cracks and crevices; along and behind baseboards; window and door frames and localized areas of floor and floor coverings where these pests may be present. Remove old bedding and replace with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. **Do not spray pets with this product.** Simultaneously treat pets with a product registered for flea and tick control on pets in conjunction with this treatment.

For Crack and Crevice

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches, Crickets, Silverfish, Sowbugs, Spiders, Brown Dog Ticks, Fleas, Earwigs and Carpet Beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Use equipment capable of delivering a pin stream in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above-listed insects hide. Avoid depositing the product onto exposed surfaces or introducing the material into the air. Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

Flies and Mosquitoes: Use only out-of-doors as an aid in reducing annoyance from these insects. Spray outside surfaces of window and doorframes as well as other areas where these pests may enter the home [building]. Also spray dark corners and localized resting areas (such as under eaves) or porches, patios and garages where these insects may congregate. Flies and mosquitoes coming to rest on treated surfaces will be killed. Repeat treatment when necessary.

Storage and Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool, dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame and other sources of ignition. **Disposal:** Do not incinerate or puncture! **If Empty:** Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If Partly Filled:** Call your local solid waste agency or 1-800-Cleanup for disposal instructions.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: May be harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing spray mist and provide adequate ventilation of area being treated. Avoid contact with skin, eyes and clothing. Thoroughly wash with soap and water after use and before smoking. Do not use in commercial food processing, preparation, storage or serving areas. In the home when used indoors, cover all food processing surfaces and utensils during treatment or thoroughly wash before use. Cover or remove exposed food. Remove pets, birds and cover fish aquariums before spraying. Do not allow children or pets to contact treated surfaces until spray has dried.

First Aid

If Swallowed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Immediately call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice. • Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. • Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by the poison control center or doctor. • Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If Inhaled	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Move person to fresh air • If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth if possible. • Call a poison control center or doctor for further treatment advice.
If on Skin or Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Take off contaminated clothing. • Immediately rinse skin with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If in Eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. • Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. • Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

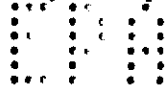
