### STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT

**IF SWALLOWED:** Immediately give several glasses of water but do not induce vomiting. If vomiting occurs, give fluids again. Have a physician determine if condition of patient will permit induction of vomiting or evacuation of stomach. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious or convulsing person.

**IF INHALED:** Remove to fresh air. If not breathing, clear the victims airway and start mouth to mouth artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen preferably with a physicians advice. Get medical attention immediately.

**IF ON SKIN:** Remove contaminated clothing immediately. Wash with soap and water. Get medical attention immediately.

**IF IN EYES:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of running water. Hold eye lids apart to ensure rinsing of the entire surface of the eye and lids with water. Get medical attention immediately.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL
