

Cover exposed food, dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Close doors and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 5,000 cubic feet of unobstructed area. Do not remain in the area during treatment and thoroughly ventilate before re-entry.

Do not use more than one fogger per room. Do not use in small, enclosed spaces such as closets, cabinets or under counters or tables. To Operate Valve: Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. Be sure to cover entire surface of stand or table to prevent damage. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table (in center of room) with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. To air out, open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes before reoccupying. Repeat treatment in two weeks or when necessary.

To Kill Ticks and Fleas: Destroy and replace pet's old bedding. Use product as above. Do not use this product on pets. Prior to reentry, treat pets with an Enforcer flea and tick control product registered for use on pets. Repeat as necessary to bring infestation under control.

Foggers alone will not control fleas and ticks. To control fleas and ticks, simultaneously treat the pet and its inside and outside living areas. [To effectively control fleas and ticks, simultaneously treat your pet, home and yard.] If you treat only your home (or only your pet) the treatment will not be effective and the fleas and ticks will return.
