DIRECTIONS FOR USE

To Kill Fleas, Lice and Ticks: Dilute 2 ounces (4 tablespoons) of concentrate with 1 gallon of water. Dip animal into solution, or sponge on solution, making sure hair is thoroughly wet to the skin. The area around the ears should be sponged thoroughly. Avoid contact of material with eyes and mouth of animal. Repeat application every two weeks or as necessary for control.

STORAGE: Store in a cool dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat or open flame. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash.
