- d. Replace "Contact a physician if irritation persists" with "Get medical attention if irritation persists."

- e. Replace "Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils" with "Before spraying, remove exposed food and cover utensils in a way preventing contamination."
- f. Add the phrase "that are not part of air ducts" to "leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls."
- g. Since your data matrix does not give a dielectrical breakdown voltage, you must add the following to the use directions:

Do not use this product in or around electrical equipment due to the possibility of shock hazard.

- 3. Comply with the requirements of the Sumithion Registration Standard.
- 4. Submit a storage stability study. The formulated product must be analyzed for its active ingredient at time zero and during a year of storage. The storage should be in warehouse conditions and in similar marketable containers you will be using in the trade. Note: For the storage stability study you cannot reference the concentrate you are using to formulate your product.
- 5. Submit five (5) copies of your final printed labeling before you release the product for shipment.

If these conditions are not complied with, the registration will be subject to cancellation in accordance with FIFRA section 6(e). Your release for shipment of the product constitutes acceptance of these conditions.

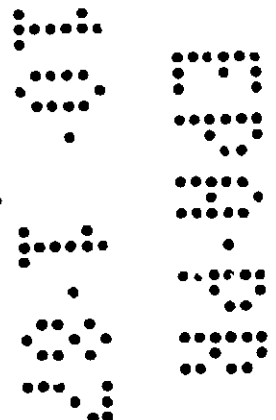

**PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

**CAUTION:** Harmful if inhaled or absorbed through skin. Avoid breathing vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with eyes and skin.

Do not use in commercial food processing or preparation areas. In the home, all food processing surfaces and utensils should be covered during treatment or thoroughly washed before use. Cover exposed food.

Remove pets, birds and cover aquariums before spraying.

**STATEMENT OF PRACTICAL TREATMENT**

**If in Eyes:** Immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. Contact a physician if irritation persists.

**If on Skin:** Immediately remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected area of skin with soap and warm water. Call a physician if irritation persists. Wash clothing prior to reuse.

**If Inhaled:** Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated. Contact a physician if necessary.

**PHYSICAL OR CHEMICAL HAZARDS**

Contents under pressure. Do not use or store near heat or open flame. Do not puncture or incinerate container. Exposure to temperatures above 130 F may cause bursting.

**SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT. APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.**

**FOR SPACE SPRAY**

To Kill flies, mosquitoes, small flying moths, gnats and wasps: Before spraying cover exposed food and utensils. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before re-entry. Sweep up and destroy fallen insects.

**FOR SPOT TREATMENT**

To kill cockroaches, ants and crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To kill exposed forms of confused flour beetles, Saw-toothed grain beetles and rice weevils: Find and destroy infested packaged goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

BACK PANEL [continued] - Enforcer Over Nite Roach Spray II

To kill sowbugs, centipedes, silverfish, firebrats and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To kill fleas and brown dog ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat pets with a registered Enforcer flea and tick control product before allowing pets to enter treated area.

**FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:**

To kill ants, cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders, brown dog ticks, fleas and carpet beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices. Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

Avoid contamination of food or food processing surfaces.

**Storage:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from heat, open flame or other sources of ignition.

**Disposal:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and discard in trash collection. Do not incinerate or puncture.
