present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To kill sowbugs, centipedes, silverfish, firebrats and spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harbouring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To kill fleas and brown dog ticks: Remove and destroy pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. Do not spray animals. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat pets with a registered Enforcer flea and tick control product before allowing pets to enter treated area.

FOR CRACK AND CREVICE:

To kill ants, cockroaches, crickets, silverfish, sowbugs, spiders, brown dog ticks, fleas and carpet beetles: Apply spray in small amounts directly into cracks and crevices.
