Pet bedding and quarters should be treated simultaneously with a product registered for use on pet bedding and quarters.

STORAGE: Store in original closed container in a cool dry area (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. **DISPOSAL:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash collection.

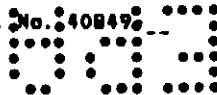

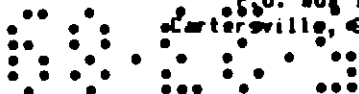
