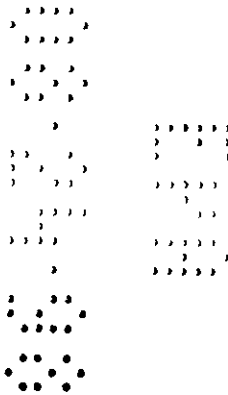

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

To shampoo and kill fleas and ticks, wet the pet's coat with warm water. Starting at the head, work shampoo thoroughly into the hair. Allow the lather to penetrate the fur for five minutes before rinsing. Dry with towel. The pet will have a clear lustrous coat free of fleas and ticks. Do not reapply product for 4 to 7 days. Do not use on puppies or kittens under 12 weeks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals.

Pet bedding and quarters should be treated simultaneously with a product registered for flea and tick control on pet bedding and quarters.

Storage: Store in original closed container in a cool dry area (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Humans: Harmful if swallowed. Causes moderate eye irritation. Avoid contact with eyes and clothing. Wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling. **Animals: Sensitivities** may occur after using ANY pesticide product for pets. If signs of sensitivity occur bathe pet with mild soap and rinse with large amounts of water. If signs continue, consult a veterinarian immediately.

First Aid

If Swallowed: Call a physician or poison control center. Drink 1 or 2 glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching back of throat with finger. If person is unconscious do not give anything by mouth and do not induce vomiting. **If in Eyes:** Flush with plenty of water. Call a physician if irritation persists.

Environmental Hazards

This product is toxic to fish. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water when disposing of equipment washwaters or rinsate.
