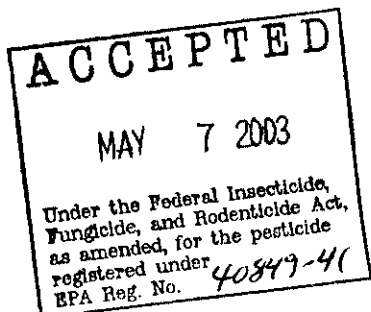

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Wet the pet's coat with warm water. Do not apply shampoo around eyes. Apply shampoo on head and ears, then lather; repeat procedure with neck, chest, middle and hind quarters, finishing legs last. Let animal stand three to five minutes (this is an important part of the grooming procedure) then thoroughly rinse animal. Dry with a towel or immediately repeat treatment on extremely dirty or scaly animals; otherwise do not reapply for 4 to 7 days. The pet will have a clear lustrous coat free of fleas and ticks. Consult a veterinarian before using this product on debilitated, medicated, aged, pregnant or nursing animals. simultaneously treat pet bedding and quarters with a product approved for premise treatment.

Storage And Disposal

Storage: Store in a cool dry (preferably locked) storage area inaccessible to children and pets. **Disposal:** Do not reuse empty container. Wrap and put in trash.
