2. Make the labeling changes listed below before you release the product for shipment:

- a. Add the phrase, "EPA Registration No. 40849-45."
- b. This product will not control all life stages of the flea. Either delete pre-adult or identify what life stages of the flea this product will control in addition to the adult stage. We assume you have data justifying such a claim.

3. Based on the current Confidential Statement of Formula (CSF) dated September 28, 1989, your product will not meet the label claim for the active ingredient. Note that the lower limit of the active must be the same as the label claim in pure active form. The lower certified limit for Esfenvalurate is 0.10% whereas the label claim states 0.40%. Please revise the label or the CSF so the information agrees.

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**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

This product will kill Cockroaches, Houseflies, Confused Flour Beetles, Saw-toothed Grain Beetles, Rice Weevils, Small Flying Moths, Fleas, Ticks, Pill Bugs, Crickets and Black Widow Spiders.

Cover exposed food dishes and food-handling equipment. Open cabinets and doors to area to be treated. Shut off fans and air conditioners. Put out all flames and pilot lights. Close door and windows. Point valve opening away from face and eyes when releasing. Use one unit for each 6,000 cubic feet (for products marketed in 7.5 oz. container) or 5,000 cubic feet (for products marketed in 6.0 oz. container) of unobstructed area. Use additional units for remote areas or where free flow of mist is not assured. Do not remain in the area during treatment and ventilate thoroughly before re-entry.

**TO OPERATE VALVE:** Place several layers of newspaper or a pad on a stand or table in the center of the room. For automatic discharge, lock valve in open position by pressing valve button all the way down, hooking the catch. Then place fogger on stand or table (in center of room) with valve locked open. Leave building at once and keep building closed for four hours before airing out. Open all doors and windows and allow to air for 30 minutes. Repeat treatment in two weeks or when necessary.

**TO KILL TICKS and FLEAS:** Destroy old pet bedding and replace. Use product as above. Do not use this product on pets. Treat pets with an ENFORCER flea & tick control product registered for use on pets.

**STORAGE:** Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets and away from direct sunlight, flames and other sources of heat or ignition.

**DISPOSAL:** Replace cap, wrap container in several layers of newspaper and dispose in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
