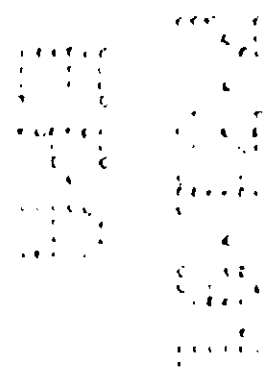

Equipment capable of delivering a pin stream should be used in points between different elements of construction, between equipment and floors, openings leading to voids and hollow spaces in walls, equipment legs and bases where the above listed insects hide.

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. Keep away from heat, open flame or sources of ignition. **DISPOSAL:** Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.
