#### SHAKE BEFORE USE. HOLD CONTAINER UPRIGHT, APPLY IN SHORT BURSTS.

#### FOR SPACE SPRAY

To Kill Flies, Gnats, Mosquitoes, Small Flying Moths and Wasps: Before spraying, cover exposed food and utensils. Close all doors and windows and direct spray upward into center of room with a slow sweeping motion. Spray 5-10 seconds for average room. Keep room closed for 15 minutes after spraying. Ventilate room thoroughly before reentry. Sweep up and discard fallen insects.

For Volumetric Treatment for Void Areas (Attics, false ceilings, crawl spaces, wall and equipment voids): For exposed stages of ants, beetles, centipedes, cockroaches, crickets, millipedes, silverfish, sowbugs and spiders harboring in voids, calculate void volume and treat at a rate of 10 seconds per 1000 cubic feet. Repeat treatment as necessary.

#### FOR SPOT TREATMENT

To Kill Ants, Cockroaches and Crickets: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray in addition to thorough spraying of all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators, food storage areas and wherever these pests are suspected of hiding. To kill ants, treat doors, around window frames, ant trails and other areas of entry. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Exposed Stages of Confused Flour Beetles, Rice Weevils and Saw-toothed Grain Beetles: Find and discard infested package goods. Remove all other items from pantry. Spray the shelves to kill any of the named insects present. Place clean paper on the shelves and return packages after shelves have dried. Repeat as necessary.

To Kill Centipedes, Firebrats, Silverfish, Sowbugs and Spiders: Contact as many insects as possible with the spray. Also thoroughly spray all parts of the room suspected of harboring these pests. Special attention should be paid to cracks, crevices, hidden surfaces under sinks, behind stoves and refrigerators.

To Kill Brown Dog Ticks and Fleas: Remove and discard pet's old bedding. Spray sleeping quarters of pets, around baseboards, window and door frames, wall cracks and local areas of floors. Repeat as necessary. DO NOT SPRAY ANIMALS WITH THIS PRODUCT. Old bedding should be removed and replaced with clean, fresh bedding after treatment. Also treat pets with a flea and tick control product registered for use on pets before allowing them to enter treated area.

To Kill Bed Bugs: Take bed apart and treat cracks, joints and interior of framework. Treat mattresses and box springs; especially tufts, folds and edges. Also treat picture frames, moldings and all cracks and crevices in the room.

To Kill Lice and Lice Eggs: Do not use on humans or animals. Treat an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect after drying, then treat entire area. Hold container upright with actuator opening directed away from you and apply from a distance of 18 inches. Treat at the rate of 1 second per 2 square feet. Treat all mattresses, furniture or similar objects that cannot be laundered or dry cleaned. Do not use article until treated area is dry. Repeat treatment as necessary.

To Kill House Dust Mites: Do not use on humans or animals. Treat at the rate of 1 second per 8 square feet. Treat an inconspicuous area to test for possible staining or discoloration. Inspect this area after drying, then treat infested areas only if staining or discoloration has not occurred. Hold container upright with actuator opening directed away from you and apply from a distance of 18 inches. Treat all mattresses, box springs, upholstery, carpet, rugs or other infested objects that cannot be laundered or dry cleaned. Do not use article until treatment is dry. Repeat treatment as necessary. Vacuum the entire room 24 to 48 hours after treating, including box springs, mattresses, carpeting, drapes, furnace and air vents to remove all dust from treated area. Clean carpeted areas when possible by vacuuming, then shampooing. For best results enclose mattress in plastic cover.

To Kill Clothes Moths and Carpet Beetles: Locate source of infestation. Treat nearby cracks and crevices and perform general volumetric treatment of infested area. To protect woolens and other keratin-containing materials, brush clean, then air out. Before treating entire article, treat a small hidden area of fabric to determine if staining will occur. Treat thoroughly by holding dispenser at least 17 inches from garment. Treated articles should be put into a darkened closet or other darkened storage such as cedar chests, storage drawers or sealable plastic fabric bags. For best protection, clean and treat inside of closets or storage areas by treating one second per 20 square feet before putting treated materials away. Treatment should be repeated every six months or as needed. Dry clean treated clothes before wearing.

To Kill Wasps and Bees: For treatment of these pests inside structural voids, locate all insect entrances. Close all but one opening. Determine size of void. Inject 5 to 10 seconds per three cubic feet of void into remaining opening. For best results, treat at dusk or later.

To Kill Mud Dauber and Sap Nests: Apply directly on insects and their nests from approximately 18 inches. Contacted insects will fly away from fog. Applications should be made in late evening when insects are at rest. Disperse into hiding and breeding places contacting as many insects as possible.

Storage: Store in a cool, dry place (preferably locked) inaccessible to children and pets. Keep away from heat, open flame or sources of ignition. Disposal: Replace cap and discard container in trash. Do not incinerate or puncture.

#### Hazards to Humans & Domestic Animals

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin or eyes. Wash with soap and water after use. If not breathing, give artificial respiration preferably mouth-to-mouth. Get medical attention.
