LAWN FLEA AND TICK CONTROL:

To kill fleas and tick harboring in lawns and backyards, use this concentrate in a hose-end sprayer. Place required amount of concentrate in sprayer jar (see chart below) and fill with water to the recommended level. Mix well. Attach to sprayer and spray as recommended. For best results, lawn should be mowed a day or two before spraying. Spray using a slow, even sweeping motion, being sure to cover the entire lawn surface where pets normally frequent. Mix concentrate in a compressed air sprayer or watering can at the rate of two (2) fluid ounces per one (1) gallon of water to control, on contact, ants, cockroaches (including German and Asian cockroaches), crickets, palmetto bugs, sowbugs, spiders and ticks.
