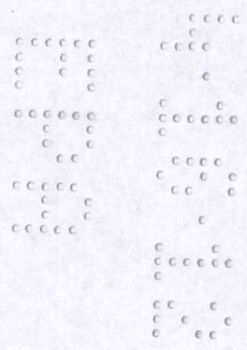

One of these ingredients, FGR®, kills fleas by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding and floor cracks. This product ultimately protects your home from reinfestation while protecting your family and pets from bites. A treatment with this spray provides continuous flea protection for up to 210 days [7 months], and leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess. When used as directed, this product will not stain furnishings or carpeting.

Fleas: Adjust spray nozzle to create a fine spray. Treat all carpeted areas and all baseboards of hard surfaced floors. Evenly apply a fine mist or spray to carpets, rugs, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture by using a wide, sweeping motion. Also spray floors underneath furniture, sofas, chairs and beds.
