#### **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

It is a violation of Federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling.

Enforcer $_{\odot}$  Flea Spray for Carpets & Furniture XX kills fleas and ticks and contains a unique combination of ingredients that kills adult fleas, flea eggs and larvae. One of these ingredients, Flealar $_{\odot}$  [Fleacor $_{\odot}$ ] [FGR $_{\odot}$ ], kills fleas by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding and floor cracks. This product ultimately protects your home from reinfestation while protecting your family and pets from bites. A treatment with this spray provides continuous flea protection for up to 120 days (4 months) and leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess. When used as directed, this product will not stain furnishings and carpeting.

Fleas, Ticks and Carpet Beetles: Shake well. Only for indoor use. Hold can 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Treat all carpeted areas and all baseboards of hard surfaced floors. Spray underneath furniture, sofas, chairs and beds. Evenly apply a fine mist or spray to carpets, rugs, drapes and all surfaces of upholstered furniture by using a wide, sweeping motion.
