

- Do not allow adults, children, or pets to enter the treated area until sprays have dried.
- Remove pets, birds, and cover fish aquariums and ornamental fish ponds before spraying, and turn aquarium systems

Enforcer[®] Flea Spray for Carpets & Furniture XX kills fleas and ticks and contains a combination of ingredients that kills adult fleas, flea eggs and larvae. One of these ingredients, Flealar[®] [Fleacor[®]] [FGR[®]], kills fleas by preventing their development into the adult biting stage. It reaches fleas hidden in carpets, rugs, drapes, upholstery, pet bedding and floor cracks. A treatment with this spray provides continuous flea protection for up to 120 days (4 months) and leaves no objectionable odor or sticky mess. When used as directed, this product will not stain furnishings and carpeting.

Fleas, Ticks and Carpet Beetles: SHAKE WELL. ONLY FOR INDOOR USE. Hold can 2 or 3 feet from surfaces to be treated. Treat all carpeted areas and all baseboards of hard surfaced floors. The flea pupae (cocoon) stage is not affected by this product because the cocoon is very difficult to penetrate. Repeated treatments and daily vacuuming required to kill fleas newly emerged from the pupae stage.
